

The **XVIII Italian** *Stata* **Conference** will this year be held in Milan on the 25th-26th September 2025 at the <u>NH Hotel Machiavelli</u>.

As always, the meeting offers participants an unique opportunity, for interdisciplinary exchange through both the presentation of new community user written commands and applied work developed in *Stata*, giving participants the opportunity to:

MEET researchers from different disciplinary areas DISCOVER new applications highlighting *Stata* 19's potential capabilities for applied research EXCHANGE new community written routines developed for *Stata* INTERACT directly with statisticians from *StataCorp*. This year Jeff Pitblado will present "*Linking frames in Stata*" and Gabriela Ortiz "*Meta-analysis in Stata*".

We are again particularly looking for new user community contributed commands focusing on:

- new estimation methods;
- Stata's connectivity to external applications, such as Python, R or Java;
- reporting tools for the creation of dynamic dashboards or automatic internet publishing;
- data visualization;
- Stata Tips and Tricks.

In 2024 we "experimented" with a new session dedicated to those users' "*Tips and Tricks*", both short and long, developed simply to make life easier in *Stata*! Due to its success, the session has been once again included in our 2025 Conference program.

The second day of the conference will be dedicated to the following training course: **Survey Data Analysis in** *Stata*.

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

Stata users interested in participating in the conference are required to submit their proposals via email to the Scientific Committee at <u>formazione@tstat.it</u> by the 25.07.2025. The accompanying e-mail should include the following information: the name of the author(s), affiliation, together with a current telephone contact, should we need to contact you.

Please note that presentations are "normally" 25 minutes long, followed by 10 minutes of discussion. Longer presentations are also welcome, in such cases however, we ask that authors indicate the additional time required. Presentations for the *Tips and Tricks* session on the other hand can range from 5 to 25 minutes.

Authors selected for presentation by the Scientific Committee will be contacted directly by the 10.08.2025. The final version of the presentation should be submitted by the 15.09.2025. Applied research in Biostatistics, Education, Epidemiology, Social and Political Sciences is also extremely welcome.
